In September 2018, Malta's Sustainable Development Vision for 2050 was adopted.

Malta's Sustainable Development Strategy for 2050, translates this Vision into a **strategic policy direction for socio-economic and environment development of the Maltese Islands**.

In drafting this Strategic Document, consultations were carried out with all Government Ministries and their respective Sustainable Development Focal Points as well as with other not-for-profit organisations and private sector representatives.

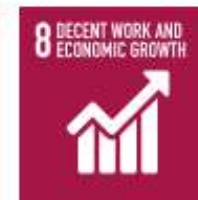
