





Health and neurological skills:





- 6. Respite Centre for those in difficulties







- 6. Number of drug related confiscations or freezing of assets.
- 7. Number of detected money laundering activities based on drug trafficking.
- 8. Number of drug users served notice to appear before Professional Committee.
- 9. Number of drug users appearing before Justice Commissioner.
